

## **Appleby Pride**

**The goal of Appleby Pride is to recognize students in grades 4 -6 for academic achievement and behavior which reflect solid effort, a positive attitude and a willingness to improve. Each quarter students are selected by their homeroom teachers to receive the Appleby Pride award based on the following criteria:**

### **Black Level**

During a qualification period the student must have:

- Overall average of 80- 100
- No more than three absences \*
- No more than three tardies \*
- Positive overall behavior in and out of class

### **Orange Level**

During a qualification period the student must have:

- Overall average of 85-100
- No more than 2 absences \*
- No more than 2 tardies \*
- Positive overall behavior in and out of class

### **Positive Behavior Characteristics**

During a qualification period the student must consistently demonstrate the following characteristics:

- Treating others respectfully
- Following school and class rules consistently
- Completing class work on time and turning homework in consistently
- Avoiding behaviors that result in a referral to the office

**Regular attendance and arriving at school on time are of equal importance to grade averages and overall behavior.**

\*Mrs. Warnow will give special consideration to those students who have experienced an illness which resulted in a prolonged absence. Tardiness due to doctor's or dentist's appointments may be given special consideration.
