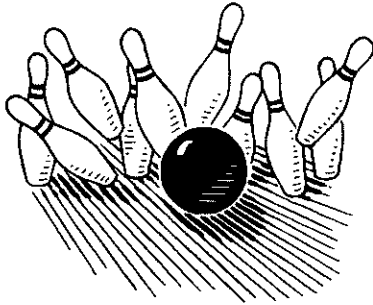


Math Bowling Directions

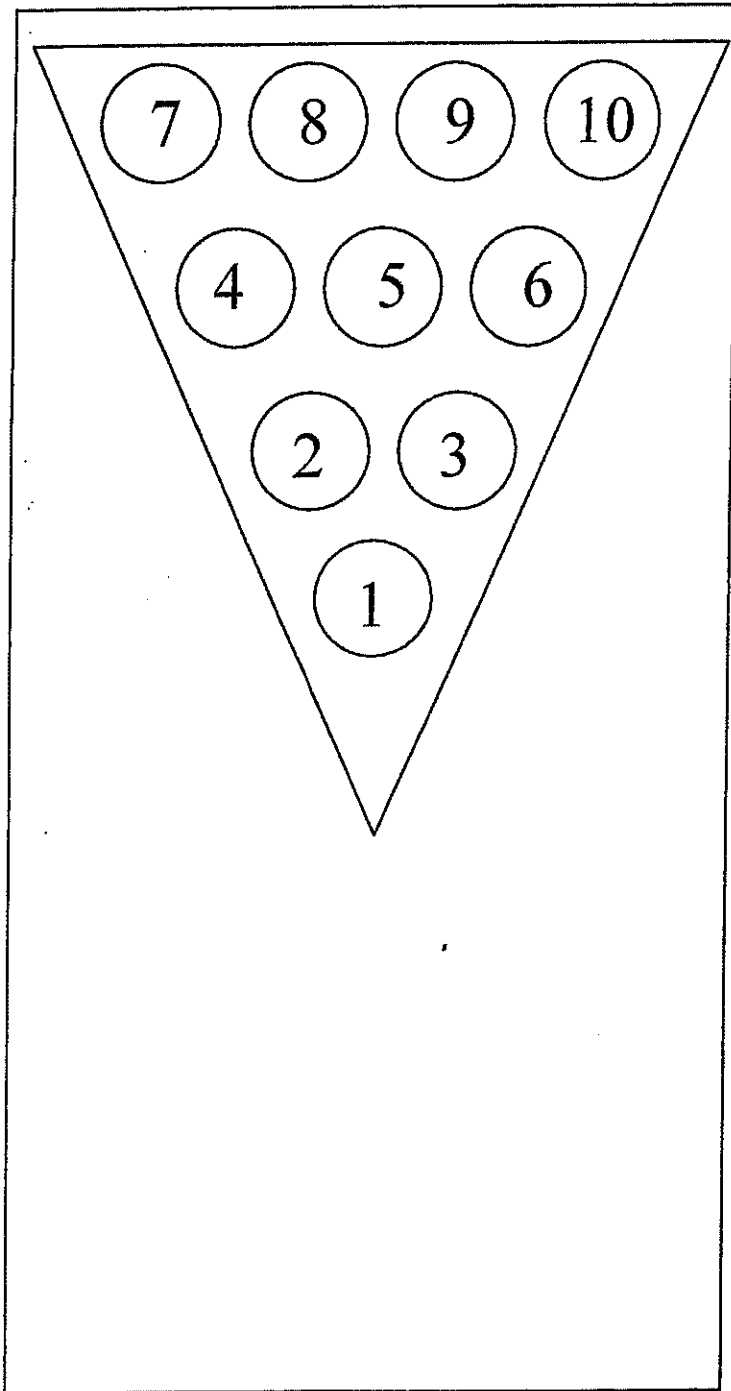
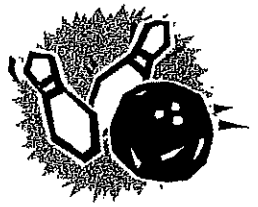


- 1) Roll the three dice and write as many expressions as you can that equal the numbers 1-10 when evaluated. Mark the numbers off on the bowling diagram and then try a second roll to knock down the rest of your pins. Keep track of your number sentences on the score sheet .
- 2) If you knock all the pins down on your first roll of frame (strike) then add 20 points to your frame total. If you get all the pins down after two rolls (spare) then add an additional 10 points to your frame total.
